

**Robert Gilbert Post-Doctoral Fellowship

The Department of Geography and Planning at Queen's University welcomes applications from excellent junior scholars conducting research in Earth System Science (the traditional disciplines of Physical Geography, or environmental research, or the impact of human activity on the Earth System) for a two-year Robert Gilbert Post-Doctoral Fellowship appointment. Salary will start at \$40,000, with the possibility of an additional teaching stipend (for a one semester-length course). Any teaching component of this position would be governed under the Collective Agreement between Queen's University Faculty Association (QUFA) and the University which is posted at <http://qufa.ca/collective-agreement/>

The criteria for distinguishing between candidates are: excellence, the quality of the research proposal (max 1,000 words, crafted in consultation with a full-time faculty member in the Department), and the relevance of the research to that of full-time faculty. Applicants must be within two years of their PhD. Applications should be sent to Warren Mabee, Head, Department of Geography and Planning, Queen's University, Kingston, ON, K7L 3N6 (c/o Joan Knox, Assistant to the Head, [knoxj@queensu.ca](mailto:knoxj@queensu.ca)) and should include a curriculum vita and the names of three referees, in addition to the research proposal.

Applications will begin to be reviewed on March 1, 2017 and will continue until the position is filled. Start date is flexible.

The department welcomes applications from women, visible minorities, aboriginal people, persons with disabilities, and persons of any sexual orientation or gender identity. All qualified candidates are encouraged to apply; however, Canadian citizens and permanent residents will be given priority.
